## *Riding Lesson Policies and Information*

Please read the following policies, initial them in the space provided, and sign below.

\_\_\_\_1. Payment is due by the first of each month, with a 5 day grace period in order to qualify for the lesson package discount. The current rates have been provided to you. Lesson payments are non-refundable.

\_\_\_\_2. Monthly Lesson packages must be used within the month.

\_\_\_\_3. A 24 hour notice of cancellation is required to be eligible for a make-up lesson. With proper notice of cancellation, we will schedule **ONE** make-up lesson for each lesson package purchased. The make-up lesson must be completed within 15 days. We cannot guarantee that our instructor will be able to schedule a make-up lesson for you due to the number of lessons already scheduled. Call us at **425-392-0600** to cancel your lesson.

\_\_\_\_4. In the event that RockMeadow must cancel lessons due to extreme weather or other unforeseen circumstances, make-up lessons will be scheduled. RockMeadow will make every reasonable effort to contact its students should it become necessary to cancel lessons.

\_\_\_\_5. Your lesson time is reserved for you. If you arrive late, you will forfeit part of your actual riding time as the lesson will end at the pre-appointed time.

\_\_\_\_6. A **Participant Release Form** must be signed before participation in any horse related activities on RockMeadow property. All students must have a **Medical Information** form on file with RockMeadow. A parent or guardian must sign for students under 18 years of age.

\_\_\_\_7. Riding Helmets and boots with a heel are required. All students, regardless of age, are required to wear helmets when riding. Children under 12 must wear a helmet while grooming, tacking up and riding.

\_\_\_\_8. Students are welcome to bring guests, parents and siblings, however we ask that visitors remain quiet and sitting in designated viewing areas. Children and guests not participating in a lesson may not help with grooming, tacking up or other handling of the horse. Please do not bring your dogs to RockMeadow.

\_\_\_\_9. Grooming, tacking up and cooling down the lesson horse is an important part of the lesson, teaching students horse management skills, responsibility, respect for the horses and property and helps develop a strong work ethic. If you do not wish to groom, tack up, cool down and put away your lesson horse, RockMeadow can provide this service for a \$25.00 fee per lesson in addition to your regular lesson price.
